Late Arrivals and Reporting Absences

- Please ensure that students arrive at school and on time at 7:50 a.m.
- When reporting absences/appointments/end-of-day changes to southhull@wqsb.qc.ca indicate the first and last name of the student, the teacher's name and the reason (if absent).

- Please report absences and/or end of day changes on the day they are absent (exceptions for vacation or lengthy absence).

End of Day Changes

Please note that due to a busy end-of-day schedule, phones may not be answered between 1:45 and 2:45. Please ensure your end of day changes are phoned in or sent by email to southhull@wqsb.qc.ca as early as possible on that day and before 1:45 p.m.

Student Safety

For the safety of all students:

- **NO ACCESS TO CRESCENT NORTH** between 7:00 - 8:30 am.
- No right turn at the top of Des Frenes Rouge.
- Abide by the municipal street signs in the school vicinity.
- Do not make any U-turns or 3-point turns in front of the school.
- Do not park in wrong direction in front of the school when dropping off students.

Students who arrive between 7:40 and 7:50 are to go into the school yard to wait for the bell to ring. Drop off should be quick to avoid congestion in front of the school. Please DO NOT drop-off your children before 7:40, (unless they go to daycare, you must walk them to the daycare door).

Parents cannot wait in the parking lot after they have dropped off their children. This is a safety issue. Staff are driving in at this time and prevents them to park their vehicle safely. Parents can stand and wait in front of gym.

Lunch Orders from Mazzola

If your child is absent from school, please be reminded that you can contact Mazzola directly and cancel your order before 9:00 am. If you are not ordering from Mazzola, please ensure that your child has a fully packed lunch and snacks for the day.



Allergies

Due to severe food allergies in the school, do not send in any fish, seafood including seaweed, and nuts/seeds of any kind.

Parents, students and staff are requested not to wear scented products of any kind due to fragrance allergies.

Lice

We are asking all parents to closely check their children for head lice. Should any be found, removal procedures must be completed immediately. Please inform the school southhull@wqsb.qc.ca if your child has lice.

General Requests

Please be reminded:

- that students are to be dressed appropriately for the weather;
- to pack extra clothing for school and daycare;
- that indoor shoes are mandatory at school and at daycare;
- to pack extra clothing/socks for wet days.
