Registrations – 2026-2027 School Year

Registrations will be held at the school (Large Gym) on February 9 and 10. Hours are: 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM and 1:00 – 5:30 PM. You may also book an appointment by emailing Linda, lhennink@wqsb.qc.ca, prior to these dates if you prefer.

You will need to provide the following documents at the time of registration:

- Child's Long form birth certificate
- Birth Certificate or Proof of Canadian Citizenship of the eligible parent
- Proof of Quebec residency: QC driver's licence (or) lease and utility bill.

We are pleased to announce that South Hull will be accepting registrations for ***a K4 program (age 4 pre-kindergarten program) starting in 2026-2027***. However, the program will only run based on the following criteria:

- We receive minimum required registrations;
- Registrations are approved by the Ministry of Education of Quebec (this is done through our registration process);



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- The application to the Ministry of Education of Quebec to run a K4 program is approved ... we are still waiting for the final approval, but things are looking positive.

Should a K4 program not be accepted at South Hull, registrations will be transferred to a waiting list for our feeder schools. Hopefully it will not get to this point.

Report Cards and Parent Teacher Interviews

Parent/Teacher Interviews will take place on **February 26 by invitation only**. Teachers will communicate with parents/guardians directly to make appointments. Should you wish to meet with your child's teacher, please reach out to them directly to schedule an appointment.
