Municipal Street Signs – No access to Crescent North

A reminder to parents/guardians/staff that there is no access to Crescent North (at the intersection of Vanier and Crescent North) between 7:00 – 8:30 a.m. There is no right turn at the top of Des Frenes Rouge if you come in from Promenade Oval.

Safety Regarding Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures Reminder

Thank you for continuing to abide by the following:

- do not drop off children at the front walkway, ***this spot is reserved for our school transporters.***
- when late, walk children to the office for check in;
- do not make a U-turn or a three-point turn in front of the school;
- do not stop on the “no stopping” side of the street (across from the school) or drop your child off across the street from the school;
- mind your speed;
- be vigilant of municipal street signs;
- end of day pick-up is promptly at 2:30 outside the front doors of the school.
