Safety for ALL STUDENTS

Safety Regarding Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures

Thank you for continuing to abide by the following:

- do not drop off children at the front walkway, **this spot is reserved for our school transporters.**
- walk your child into the school in the morning (for safety);
- do not make a U-turn or a three-point turn in front of the school;
- do not stop on the "no stopping" side of the street (across from the school) or drop your child off across the street from the school;
- mind your speed;
- be vigilant of municipal street signs;
- do not "stand around/linger" in the daycare parking lot as this area is extremely busy.
